

D2L: Assessing Discussions


Open the Communication Menu and select **Discussions**.




Open the menu for a Topic, then select **Edit Topic**.




On the next page, select the **Assessment** tab.



You can choose to link to an existing grade item or create and link to a new one. Enter the points value of the Topic in the **Score**Out Of field.




If you use the D2L Rubrics tool, you can link to a Rubric. You can also choose to assess each individual post a student makes.



To save your choices, select **Save** or **Save and Close**.

You can tell whether a Topic is linked to the Gradebook by looking for the **ribbon icon**.




Assessing/Grading Discussions

There are two ways to get to the assessment area:


Option 1:

Open the menu beside a Topic and select **Assess Topic**.



On the next screen, you will see a list of your students. Select**Topic Score** to see their posts and assess their work.



Option 2: Open the menu on a student's post in a Topic and select Assess Student.



- In the pop-up window, you can do the following to assess the student's work:
 - 1. Enter a score in the **TopicScore** field
 - 2. Leave the student **General Feedback**
 - 3. View all posts the student made for the Topic
 - 4. Click **Publish** to save their score and feedback, or **Save Draft** should you not wish to publish just yet.
