

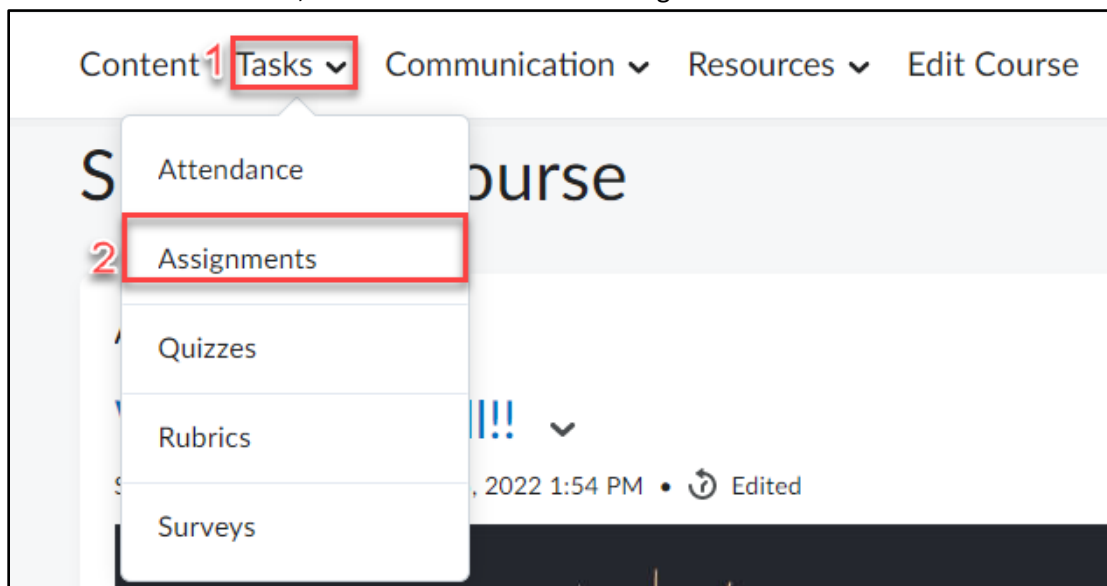

Excluding Assignment Templates in Turnitin

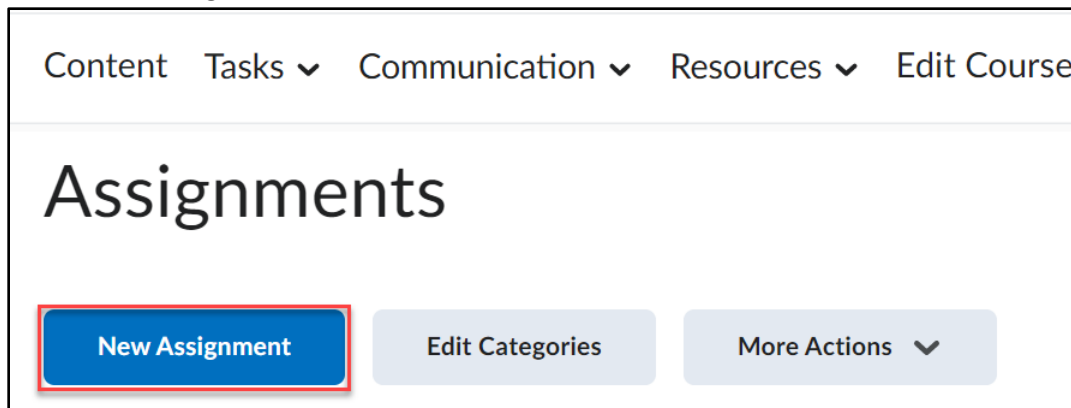
Occasionally, instructors provide students with templates (prompts, worksheets, etc.) and this text is included in the student’s assignment. If all students within the class submit the same template, it will influence their Similarity Report. Instructors can now upload a template to the Turnitin assignment settings so that it can be automatically excluded from all students' Similarity Reports in that class.

The steps below cover how to create a D2L assignment, enable Turnitin, and add a template for exclusion. You can add a template to a D2L assignment that has already been created; however, **you must enable Turnitin and add the template before students make submissions to the assignment folder.**

1. Access the course in D2L, select “Tasks” and then “Assignments.”



2. Select “New Assignment”



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3. Fill out the form with the new assignment information. When you are done, select “Evaluation & Feedback” and then “Manage Turnitin.”

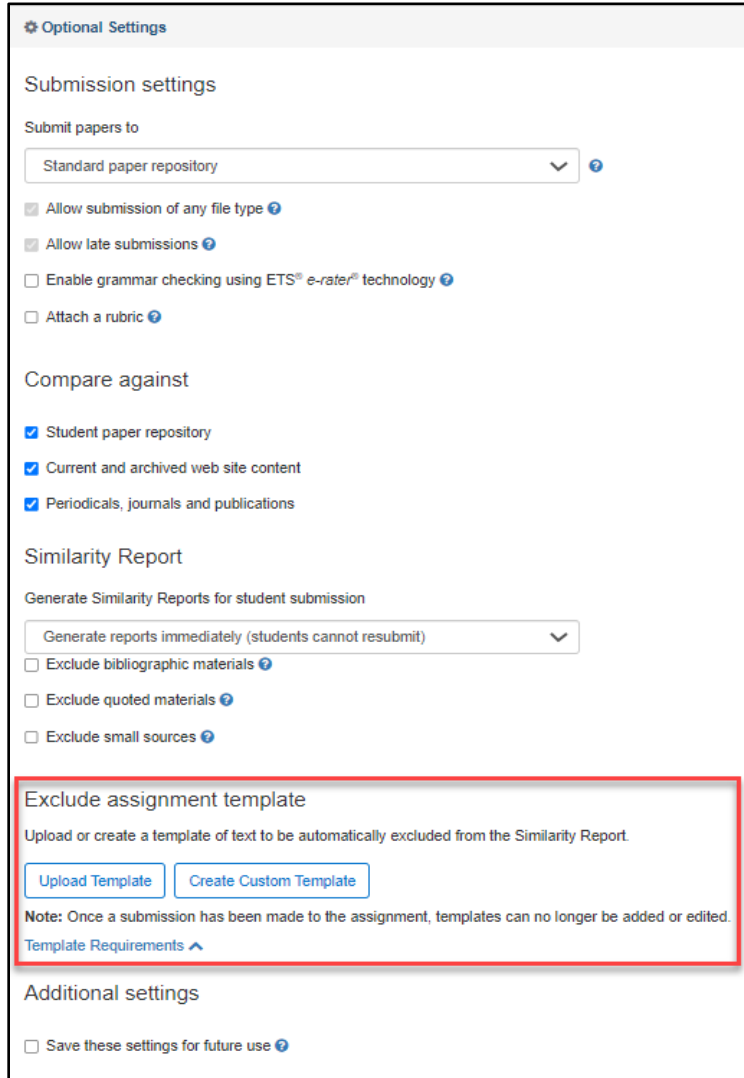

4. Complete the form to your preferences to integrate Turnitin into this assignment. At the minimum, you must check “Enable Similarity Report for this folder” which is necessary to add the template for exclusion. You can also “Enable Online Grading for this folder” if desired. Then, select “More Options.”

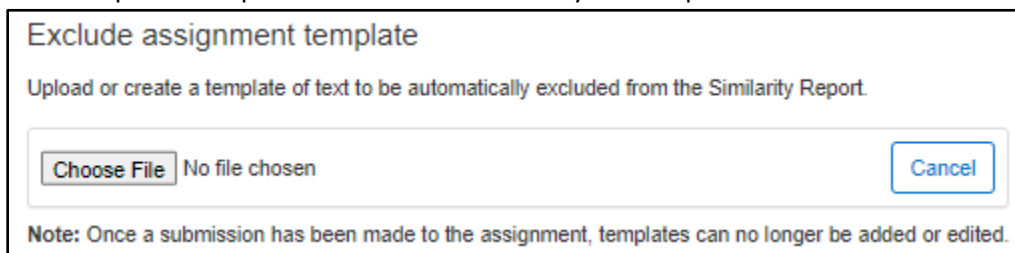
