Policy Statement

It is the policy of Austin Peay State University to encourage students, faculty, and staff to participate in and make recommendations regarding University policies and programs.

Purpose

To establish an effective means whereby students, faculty, and staff can participate in and make recommendations concerning the formation of policies and programs relating to student and academic matters.

- A. The Austin Peay State University Board of Trustees (the Board) recognizes that students, faculty, and staff are vital components of the campus community, which must effectively contribute to the progress and general welfare of Austin Peay State University.
- B. Students should have a primary interest in matters of student life, including: discipline and housing, and faculty should have a primary interest in academic affairs, including: new course development, new curriculum development, curriculum modifications, admission and graduation requirements. Furthermore, students, faculty, and staff have a direct interest in both student and academic matters.
- C. Therefore, it is the policy of the Board that Austin Peay State University shall establish effective means whereby students, faculty, and staff can participate in and make

recommendations concerning the formation of policies and programs relating to student and academic matters.
