President Licari's Report

- Announced last week that a government shutdown may affect military students using tuition assistance. University will cover that tuition.
- Met with THEC last week regarding the strategic plan, which will come to a vote at the November meeting. The plan's three cornerstones are: aligned, achievable, and agile. APSU's current strategic plan expires in June 2027. Open forums will be held in spring to celebrate the current plan, identify accomplishments, and shape the next strategic plan.
- SLT is examining degree attainment benefits. While the previous pay bump structure may not return, a bonus structure is being considered. Due to changes in IRS code for employee benefits, amounts over a certain threshold will become taxable. Supervisors will verify that degrees are relevant to employees' current positions to avoid tax liability.
- A working group on freedom of expression and civil discourse will be created to develop a values document. The group will include representatives from all university areas: faculty, staff, and students.
- Question about free general admission for faculty/staff. President Licari will follow up on this matter.
- Question about if the salary database would be integrated into Gov's Suite. It will be added to Self Service.

- Need for clear language, as interpretations of "professional" vary by supervisor
- Consideration of dress code applicable to all employees
