

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 SUMMARY

- A. This Section includes the following:
 - Exterior mounted Plaques one at vertical face of pedestals and one at top sloped surface of pedestals. See drawings for typical text example of plaques. Actual text patterns will be similar and will be furnished to contractor following bidding. There are nine (9) total pedestals resulting in nine (9) vertical plaques and nine (9) top plaques mounted on sloped top surface of pedestals.

1.2 **SUBMITTALS**

- A. Product Data: For each type of product indicated.
- B. Shop Drawings: Submit "rubbing" of copy for plaques.

PART 2 - PRODUCTS

2.1 MATERIALS

- A. Aluminum Castings: (Basis of Design) Aluminum Castings: 514 Allow Satin Sheen Two (2) coat 10 year warranty.
- B. Bronze Castings: (Add Alternate) ASTM B 584, Alloy UNS No. C86500 (No. 1 manganese bronze).

2.2 PLAQUES

- A. Available Manufacturers: Subject to compliance with requirements, manufacturers offering products that may be incorporated into the Work include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - 1. Southwell Company.
- B. Cast Plaque: Provide castings free of pits, scale, sand holes, and other defects, as follows:
 - 1. Plaque Material: Aluminum (Basis of Design) / Bronze (Add Alternate).
 - 2. Size: As indicated on Drawings.
 - 3. Background Texture: Manufacturer's standard stipple texture.
 - 4. Border Style: Square, polished.
 - 5. Mounting: Concealed studs for substrates encountered.
- C. Quantity: Provide Two (2) plaques per pedestal.
- D. Architect to provide text / graphics for fabrication.





2.3 INSTALLATION

- A. Locate signs and accessories where indicated, using mounting methods of types described and complying with manufacturer's written instructions.
 - 1. Install signs level, plumb, and at heights indicated, with sign surfaces free of distortion and other defects in appearance.
- B. Cast-Metal Plaque: Mount plaque using standard fastening methods to comply with manufacturer's written instructions for type of wall surface indicated.
 - 1. Concealed Mounting: Mount plaques by inserting threaded studs into tapped lugs on back of plaque. Set in predrilled holes filled with quick-setting cement.
