Book Reviews

- Notes and Bibliography Style:
- **Note:** First Name Last Name, "Title of Review," review of *Title of Book*, by Author Name, Publication Name, Month Day, Year.
 - Example: Alexandra Jacobs, "The Muchness of Madonna," review of *Madonna: A Rebel Life*, by Mary Gabriel, New York Times, October 8, 2023.
- Shortened note: Last Name, "Shortened Review Title."
 - Example: Jacobs, "Muchness of Madonna."
- **Bibliography entry:** Last Name, First Name. "Title of Review." Review of *Title of Book*, by Author Name. Publication Name, Month Day, Year.
 - Example: Jacobs, Alexandra. "The Muchness of Madonna." Review of *Madonna: A Rebel Life*, by Mary Gabriel. New York Times, October 8, 2023.
- Author-Date Style:
- In-text Citation: (Author Last Name Year)
 - Example: (Jacobs 2023)
- **Reference List:** Author Last Name, First Name. Year. "Title of Review." Review of *Title of Book*, by Book Author First Name Last Name. Newspaper or Magazine Name, Month Day.
 - Example: Jacobs, Alexandra. 2023. "The Muchness of Madonna." Review of *Madonna: A Rebel Life*, by Mary Gabriel. New York Times, October 8.
