Student Etutoring Expectations

Before The Appointment

- Upload your assignment sheet and your paper as a Microsoft Word file (.doc or .docx) at least 1 hour before your appointment.
- If you do not upload the assignment sheet or written work, your appointment may be canceled.

How eTutoring Works

- No live meeting is required. After the session, your tutor will upload written feedback to the **Attached Files** section of your appointment. Log in to mywconline, open your appointment, and download the feedback when it's ready.

What to Expect

In a 30-minute session, a tutor typically reviews about 2 to 3 pages. Please indicate which section(s) you want the tutor to focus on. They may prioritize:

- The **introduction** and how it frames your argument
- **Main ideas** and paragraph structure
- Use of **citations** and sources
- The **conclusion**
- Works Cited or References pages

Feedback You Will Receive

- Tutors provide specific, constructive feedback. Feedback highlights both strengths and areas to improve. Examples:
 - “Your transitions between paragraphs are clear and strengthen your argument.”
 - “Consider expanding your analysis in paragraph two to better support your main point.”

After The Review

- Your tutor will complete a **Client Report Form** that summarizes what was reviewed and what still needs attention. Most of your detailed feedback will appear directly on your paper in the **attached Word document**, where you can see **in-line comments** or **comment bubbles** from your tutor.
