### AIP Style 4th Edition - Citation Guide

#### In-text Citations

- References must be cited in numerical order (e.g., first citation is <sup>1</sup>, second is <sup>2</sup>, etc.).
- Use superscript Arabic numerals for citations.
- Place citation numbers after punctuation marks (e.g., periods, commas).
- Avoid placing citation numbers where they could be confused with other numbers (e.g., dates, figures).
- Use "et al." (no comma before "et") for multiple authors in the body of the text.
- In the reference list, give all authors' names unless there are more than six—then you may use "et al." after the first few.

#### References List

- List references in numerical order, matching the in-text citation numbers.
- Use the same superscript numeral as used in the text for each reference entry.
- **Be consistent with name formatting:**
  - Both "T.I. Wein" and "T. I. Wein" are correct—just be consistent.
- Use full or accepted abbreviated journal/conference titles, but be consistent throughout the list.
- **For conference proceedings, include:**
  - Conference name, location, and year
  - Editors and publisher (if available)
  - Page numbers
- **For technical reports, include:**
  - Name of the laboratory or institution
  - Report number and year
  - Title, if available (especially if there's no report number)

#### Book with Single Author

##### Reference Page Format

Author's Initial. Last Name, *Book Title* (Publisher, Place of Publication, Year), pp. page range.

##### Examples

S. Hemmingsen, *Soft Science* (University of Saskatchewan Press, Saskatchewan, 1997), pp. 123-321.

M. O. Johnson, *The Sound of Knowing* (Harvard University Press, Cambridge, 2004), pp. 45-110.

#### Book with Multiple Authors

##### Reference Page Format

First Author's Initial. Last Name and Second Author's Initial. Last Name, *Book Title* (Publisher, Place of Publication, Year), pp. page range.

##### Examples

S. Hemmingsen and Q. Cai, *Soft Science* (University of Saskatchewan Press, Saskatchewan, 1997), pp. 123-321.

L. M. Torres and D. R. Bennett, *Mapping the Mind* (Oxford University Press, Oxford, 2012), pp. 50-198.

**Book with edition number**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), *Book Title*, Edition (Publisher, Location, Year), pp. Page Range.

**Examples**

S. Hemmingsen and Q. Cai, *Soft Science*, 2nd ed. (University of Saskatchewan Press, Saskatchewan, 1997), pp. 123-321.

J. Smith and R. Doe, *Modern Physics*, 3rd ed. (Cambridge University Press, Cambridge, 2015), pp. 45–89.

**Book with volume and edition numbers**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), *Book Title*, Edition (Publisher, Location, Year), Vol. Volume Number, pp. Page Range.

**Examples**

S. Hemmingsen and Q. Cai, *Soft Science*, 2nd ed. (University of Saskatchewan Press, Saskatchewan, 1997), Vol. II, pp. 123-321.

A. Johnson, *Theoretical Chemistry*, 4th ed. (Oxford University Press, Oxford, 2012), Vol. I, pp. 10–210.

**Material in edited book**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), in *Book Title*, edited by Editor(s) (Publisher, Location, Year).

**Examples**

S. Hemmingsen and Q. Cai, in *Soft Science*, edited by L. Winterbottom and S. Schechter (University of Saskatchewan Press, Saskatchewan, 1997).

M. Lang and K. Ruiz, in *Advances in Climate Research*, edited by P. Stone (Springer, New York, 2019).

**Material in edited book, with volume number**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), in *Book Title*, edited by Editor(s) (Publisher, Location, Year), Vol. Volume Number, pp. Page Range.

**Examples**

S. Hemmingsen and Q. Cai, in *Soft Science*, edited by L. Winterbottom (University of Saskatchewan Press, Saskatchewan, 1997), Vol. II, pp. 123-321.

E. Turner, in *Global Environmental Studies*, edited by N. Wells and T. Clarke (Routledge, London, 2020), Vol. III, pp. 55–150.

**Journal Article**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), *Journal Name* Volume, Page Range (Year).

**Examples**

S. Limsombatanan and N. Bobeya, *IEEE Transactions on Computers* 46, 695–701 (1997).

H. Patel and S. Zhu, *Journal of AI Research* 62, 150–165 (2021).

**Journal Article with Issue Number**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), *Journal Name* Volume (Issue), Page Range (Year).

**Examples**

S. Limsombatanan and N. Bobeya, *IEEE Transactions on Computers* 46 (5), 695–701 (1997).

D. Costa and A. Wills, *Machine Learning Letters* 14 (3), 89–104 (2023).

**Journal Article with Author et al.**

**Reference Page Format**

First Author et al., *Journal Name* Volume, Page Range (Year).

**Examples**

S. Limsombatanan et al., *IEEE Transactions on Computers* 46, 695–701 (1997).

R. Mendes et al., *Neural Computing* 39, 210–230 (2024).

**Journal Article Including the Article Title**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), “Title of the Article,” *Journal Name* Volume, Page Range (Year).

**Examples**

S. Limsombatanan and N. Bobeya, “TDM and TWDM de Bruijn networks and shufflenets for optical communications,” *IEEE Transactions on Computers* 46, 695–701 (1997).

L. Ren and M. Adler, “Quantum embedding for combinatorial optimization,” *Nature Quantum Tech* 5, 45–60 (2022).

**Article with Simultaneous Publication in Translation**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), *Original Journal* Volume, Page (Year) [*Translated Journal* Volume, Page (Year)].

**Examples**

L. G. Aslamosov and A. I. Larkin, *Fiz Tverd. Tela* (Leningrad) 10, 1104 (1968) [*Sov. Phys. Solid State* 10, 875 (1968)].

M. Kwon and T. Oh, *Hanguk Jeonja Hakhoe* 58, 210 (2021) [*Korean J. Electron.* 58, 210 (2021)].

**Article to Be Published**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), *Journal Name* (to be published).

**Examples**

F. W. Tseng, J. H. Kim, and K. Iwata, *Phys. Rev. B* (to be published).

S. Liang and E. Grant, *IEEE Transactions on Neural Networks* (to be published).

Author(s) (unpublished).

**Article in Proceedings**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), *Proc. Name* Volume, Page Range (Year).

**Examples**

K. Nguyen and N. Luc, *Proc. R. Soc. Paris Ser. B* 36, 145–170 (1997).

J. Lee and A. Campos, *Proc. Int. Conf. Robotics and Automation* 112, 34–48 (2023).

**Article from proceedings of a symposium or conference**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), in *Conference Name*, Location, Year, pp. Page Range.

**Examples**

C. Yaakov and R. Huque, in *Second International Telecommunications Energy Symposium '97*, Copenhagen, Denmark, 1997, pp. 17-27.

A. Becker and N. Ishikawa, in *IEEE International Symposium on Robotics and Automation 2023*, Tokyo, Japan, 2023, pp. 88–96.

**Article from edited proceedings with publisher information**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), Conference Proceedings Title, edited by Editor(s) (Publisher, Location, Year), pp. Page Range.

**Examples**

C. Yaakov and R. Huque, *Second International Telecommunications Energy Symposium Proceedings*, edited by E. Yow (IEEE, New York, 1996), pp. 17-27.

M. Salazar and B. Cheng, *Proceedings of the Future of Quantum Computing*, edited by T. L. Moore (Springer, Berlin, 2022), pp. 205–219.

**Article from edited conference proceedings, published under a separate title**

**Reference Page Format**

Author(s), in *Separate Published Title, Proceedings of the Conference Name*, Location, Year, edited by Editor(s), *Series Info* (Publisher, Location, Year).

**Examples**

C. Yaakov and R. Huque, in *Telecommunications Energy International, Proceedings of the 2nd International Telecommunications Energy Conference*, Copenhagen, 1997, edited by J. Choi, J-Y. Yang, and J. Sinogeikina, AIP Conf. Proc. No. 42 (AIP, New York, 1997).

F. Tanaka and G. Allen, in *Trends in Deep Learning, Proceedings of the 2022 Global AI Conference*, Munich, 2022, edited by L. Ortega and P. Bhatt, Springer Lecture Notes in AI No. 598 (Springer, Berlin, 2023).

#### **Published proceedings from a meeting/conference**

##### **Reference Page Format**

Author(s), *Proceedings Title*, Location, Publisher Identifier or Number (Publisher, Location, Year), pp. Page Range.

##### **Examples**

C. Yaakov and R. Huque, *Proceedings of the Second International Telecommunications Energy Conference*, Copenhagen, IEEE Pub. No. 320CMORE2-75 (IEEE, New York, 1997), pp. 17–27.

R. Jameson and E. Myung, *Proceedings of the International Conference on Human-Centered AI*, Seoul, ACM Pub. No. HC-AI-2301 (ACM, New York, 2023), pp. 301–312.

#### **Article from Conference Proceedings to Be Published in Another Journal**

##### **Reference Page Format**

Author(s), in *Conference Proceedings Title*, Location, Year [*Journal Name* (to be published)].

##### **Examples**

C. Yaakov and R. Huque, in *Proceedings of the Second International Telecommunications Energy Conference*, Copenhagen, 1997 [J. Phys. Rev (to be published)].

D. Aranda and H. Kim, in *Proceedings of the 2024 International Symposium on Neuromorphic Systems*, San Diego, 2024 [IEEE Trans. Neural Networks (to be published)].

#### **Private Communications**

##### **Reference Page Format**

Author(s) (private communication, Year).

##### **Examples**

R. Kibiro Waweru and A. Gakure (private communication, 1997).

S. Linden and P. Cho (private communication, 2022).

#### **Computer Program**

##### **Reference Page Format**

Author, computer code *Program Name* (Institution/Company, Location, Year).

##### **Examples**

M. F. Verde, computer code *MIKE* (IBM Laboratories, Pleasantville, NY, 1996).

J. Al-Khatib, computer code *NeuroSim* (OpenAI Research Labs, San Francisco, CA, 2023).

#### **Patent**

##### **Reference Page Format**

Author(s), U.S. Patent No. Number (Date).

##### **Examples**

K. Kimura and A. Lipeles, U.S. Patent No. 14,860,040 (14 December, 1996).

L. Carter and M. Dubois, U.S. Patent No. 11,345,678 (22 July, 2021).
