AMA In-Text Citations (11th Edition)

- Cite any quoted or paraphrased information from a source.
- Use superscript Arabic numerals (^{1,2,3}) for citations.
- Number citations consecutively in the order they first appear in your paper.
- Reuse the original number if citing the same source again.

Example:

Detailed chemical and pharmacological information is available for escitalopram oxalate.¹

Placement of Superscript Numbers

- Place outside periods and commas.
- Place inside colons and semicolons.

Examples:

As reported previously,^{1,3-8,19}

The derived data were as follows³⁻⁵:

Reference Page

- List references in the order they appear in-text (not alphabetical).
- Use AMA format for journals, books, and other sources.

Reference Example

1. Compound summary for CID 146571: Escitalopram Oxalate. PubChem Compound Database.

AMA Style – Citing Websites

In-Text Citation Format: Use **superscript 1** for the first source: ¹

Sentence with In-Text Citation Example: This concept is explained in detail.¹

- The superscript in-text matches the number in the reference list.
- Number citations consecutively in the order they appear.
- Reuse the same number if citing the same source again.

Citing Websites

Reference Format

Author(s). Page Title. URL. Published date. Accessed date.

Reference Example:

1. National Institute of Health and Care Excellence (NICE). Diabetic foot problems: prevention and management. National Guideline Clearinghouse.

<http://www.guideline.gov/content.aspx?id=49566&search=diabetes>. Published August 26, 2015. Accessed April 25, 2016.

Citing Websites with No Author or Date

Reference Format

Page Title. Website Title. URL. Accessed date.

Reference Example:

1. Compound summary for CID 146571: Escitalopram Oxalate. PubChem Compound Database.

<https://pubchem.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/compound/146571>. Accessed April 16, 2019.

Citing Online Videos

Reference Format

Video Title [video online]. Year. URL. Accessed date.

Reference Example:

1. The Narcotic Farm - Part 1/3 [video online]. 2008.

<http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8BZrsAh4kd0&feature=related>. Accessed October 22, 2017.

Citing Podcasts

Reference Format

Authors(s). Podcast Title. Date. URL. Accessed date.

Reference Example:

1. Mason J, Bavolek R. Placenta Previa. Emergency Medicine Reviews and Perspectives.

October 1, 2018. <https://www.emrap.org/episode/emrap20181/placentaprevia>. Accessed

November 21, 2018.
