### Citing Podcasts

- **Basic Format:** Host Last Name, First Initial. (Host). (Year–Year or Year–present). *Title of Podcast* [Audio or Video podcast]. Production Company. URL

### Instructions

- List the host as the author and include their role in parentheses (e.g., Host).
  - You may list executive producers instead, if known.
- List podcast dates as:
  - **Ongoing podcast:** Year–present (e.g., 2020–present)
  - **Ended podcast:** Start–End years (e.g., 2017–2020)
  - **Single-year podcast:** Year only (e.g., 2019)
- Include the podcast type in brackets.

### Examples

Meraji, S. M., & Demby, G. (Hosts). (2016–present). *Code switch* [Audio podcast]. National Public Radio.

Seales, A. (Host). (2018–present). *Small doses with Amanda Seales* [Audio podcast]. Starburns Audio.

### In-Text Citations

- **Parenthetical Format:** (Author, Year–Year)
  - **Examples:** (Meraji & Demby, 2016–present; Seales, 2018–present)
- **Narrative citations:** Author (Year–Year)
  - **Examples:** Meraji and Demby (2016–present) and Seales (2018–present)

### **Citing Podcast Episodes**

- **Basic Format:** Host Last Name, First Initial. (Host). (Year, Month Day). Title of episode (No. #)  
[Audio or Video podcast episode]. In *Title of Podcast*. Production Company. URL

### **Instructions**

- List the episode host as the author and include their role in parentheses.
- Include the full release date of the episode.
- Add the episode number in parentheses after the title (omit if not numbered).
- Include the episode type in brackets.
- Write In followed by the podcast title in italics.
- End with the episode URL (omit if unavailable).

### **Example**

Hannah-Jones, N. (Host). (2019, September 13). How the bad blood started (No. 4) [Audio podcast episode]. In *1619*. The New York Times. <https://podcasts.apple.com/us/podcast/episode-4-how-the-bad-blood-started/id1476928106?i=1000449718223>

### **In-Text Citations**

- **Parenthetical Format:** (Author, Year)
  - **Examples:** (Hannah-Jones, 2019) and (Webster & Abumrad, 2020)
- **Narrative Format:** Author (Year)
  - **Examples:** Hannah-Jones (2019) and Webster and Abumrad (2020)

- **Basic Format:** Host Last Name, First Initial. (Host). (Year, Month Day). Title of episode (No. #) [Audio or Video podcast episode]. In *Title of Podcast*. Production Company. URL

**In-Text Citations**

- **Parenthetical Format:** (Author, Year)

**In-Text Citations**

- **Narrative Citation Format:** Author (Year)
