Citing YouTube Videos in APA 7th Edition

Basic Format :Author, A.A. (year, month day). *Title of video* [Video]. YouTube. URL

Examples

Asian Boss. (2020, June 5). World’s leading vaccine expert fact-checks COVID-19 vaccine conspiracy: Stay curious #22 [Video]. YouTube.

- **Examples:** (NASA, 2019) or (Harvard University, 2019)

Narrative Format: Author (Publication Year)

- **Examples:** NASA (2019) or Harvard University (2019)

YouTube Channel

Basic Format: Author, A.A. (n.d.). *Title of channel* [YouTube channel]. Retrieved month day, year, from URL
